Our EOI was shortlisted to full application submission by the Women's Health Round of the Hospital Research Foundation. In this proposal titled "Cardiac Rehabilitation Especially for Women (CREW): a person-centred, co-designed model of care embedded within an existing web-based cardiac rehabilitation program to improve attendance and clinical outcomes for women living in rural and remote areas with cardiovascular disease", we are building on CHAP to tailor cardiac rehabilitation (CR) to meet women's needs and preferences particularly regarding social support and exercise training through CATCH web. We aim to increase CR attendance and completion among women living in rural and remote areas and in the long-term improve their clinical and patient-reported outcomes.


